Ngoorabul people are the traditional custodians of the Glen Innes area and their totem is the Koala. As part of our IPA we manage the environment to the best our ability and taking into consideration of traditional practices such as fire burning of sections of the lands at the appropriate time. Purchase of key habitat lands in and around the Glen Innes area to build connectivity to provide areas of food in all conditions eg, food areas along river courses in times of drought. Need to start building up food areas that have been cleared and protect ones that already exist. Also need to provide a continuation of programs to support management of these areas along the traditional Aboriginal management of country.
