

Office of Environment and Heritage Emu Egg Carving Licence Conditions Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016

The following licence conditions are current at the time of publication and are subject to change at any time.

Licence conditions

- 1. The licensee will provide a report of the activities allowed by this licence prior to the renewal or at the termination of this licence. The report shall contain a statement as to the number of eggs acquired, from whom, and number of eggs disposed of under such authority.
- 2. Eggs acquired or purchased must have the licence number of the supplier written or etched on the egg. A licence number (e.g. MWL009999) must also be etched on all eggs carved and disposed of under such authority. If using a permanent mount, the above numbers may be etched on the base of the mount.
- 3. Eggs not to be taken from the wild.
