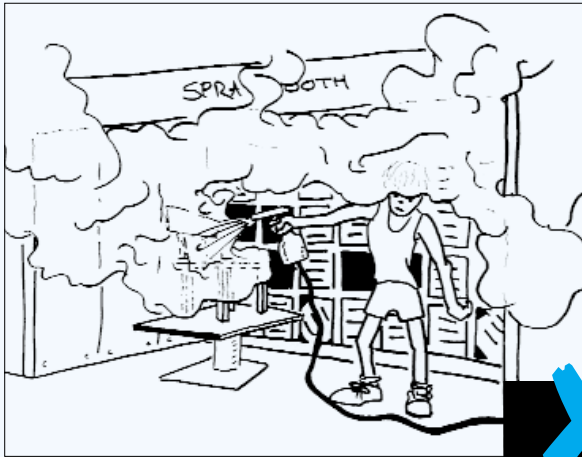


STOP air pollution

SMOKE, dust, chemical vapours, fumes and odours can all cause air pollution. It is against the law to cause air pollution. Here are some ways to help prevent air pollution at your workplace.

- Control any fumes or vapours that smell. If you need special advice on controlling these smells, contact your local Council. If you use chemicals make sure all workers and the community are protected from any fumes.
- Control dust from your yards and work areas.
- Do not burn your rubbish - burning off is illegal.
- If you are working in a spray booth:
 - ensure that the filters cover the entire vent area;
 - ensure that the fan venting system is in good working order;
 - maintain the filters in good working order;
 - use airless spray guns or high volume low pressure guns to minimise paint wastage.



- If you are spray painting, make sure you only use a spray booth. Also be very careful of overspray.
