



Section 120 *National Parks & Wildlife Act 1974*

APPLICATION FOR A COMPANION NATIVE ANIMAL KEEPERS' LICENCE

Follow these steps:

1. Only use this application form if you are a resident of NSW
2. Tick the box for the class of licence you wish to apply for. You can only apply for one class of Companion Native Animal Keepers' Licence. You can only hold one animal under this licence
3. Write in the class fee you wish to apply for. This will be the total amount you need to pay
4. Read the NOTES below and complete the rest of the application form
5. Email the form to wildlife.licensing@environment.nsw.gov.au or post it to Wildlife Licensing and Management Unit, PO Box 1967, Hurstville NSW 1481. Applications cannot be lodged in person at the Hurstville office
6. Payment can ONLY be made by Credit Card, Cheque or Money Order (made payable to the Department of Environment, Climate Change and Water)

NOTES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ An applicant must be over 16 years of age to apply for a Companion Native Animal Keepers' Licence. If you are under 16 years of age and interested in keeping native animals as pets, you still can, however, the licence application must be in the name of your legal parent/guardian. The licence will be issued in the name of the legal parent/guardian who will be responsible for compliance with the licence conditions while still allowing those under 16 years of age to care for and provide husbandry requirements to the animal(s). ▪ An applicant cannot possess or acquire any animals(s) before the granting of a Companion Native Animal Keepers' Licence ▪ If you are applying and believe you are eligible for a pensioner discount, you must provide a copy of both sides of your pension card ▪ If you want to keep more than one protected native animal you will need to apply for a Native Animal Keepers' Licence ▪ Please allow twenty one (21) working days for the processing of your application ▪ If a licensee requests that their licence be cancelled within 30 days of being issued, a refund may be paid minus a \$40 administration fee. No refund is possible after 30 days has elapsed or if animals have already been acquired ▪ A maximum penalty of \$3,300 applies for supplying a false statement or providing misleading information in an application for a licence or certificate by an applicant ▪ This application form contains information that identifies you and is defined as "personal information" under the NSW <i>Privacy and Personal Information Act 1998</i> (PPIP Act). DECCW collects and manages the personal information you provide in accordance with the PPIP Act. DECCW will not use personal information except for purposes listed as exemptions in the PPIP Act. ▪ Information supplied on this form will be used by officers of DECCW to assess your application. Information collected by DECCW may be disclosed to third parties for the purposes of confirming information provided by you in this application, and for law enforcement purposes. Personal information collected by DECCW will be stored securely and disposed according to the DECCW Records Management Policy.
