To Hold Preserved Fauna and/or Carry Out Taxidermy

This form is to be used for applications to hold preserved protected fauna (including skeletal material) and for applications to carry out taxidermy on protected species on either a hobby or professional basis. **Note**: A licence may not be issued to a private person, or to a non-educational facility, to hold a specimen of a bird of prey or a threatened species, unless the applicant can demonstrate there is a legitimate and worthwhile scientific or educational justification for holding the specimen.

All applicants must complete Parts 1 and 5 and either Part 2, Part 3 or Part 4 of the form. Please use block letters to complete this form.
