Application for a Biodiversity Conservation Licence under the *Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016* to harm protected animals (kangaroos and wallaroos) and possess and sell the carcasses for commercial purposes.

All sections must be completed before the application will be processed.

Applicants are required to successfully complete two different courses before applying for this licence: (1) an OTEN TAFE course for Statement of Attainment in Game Harvester Skill Set, and (2) the Firearms Accreditation for Kangaroo Harvesters run by the Firearm Safety & Training Council Ltd.

Office of Environment and Heritage may disclose this information to the Australian Quarantine and Inspection Service (AQIS) and NSW Food Authority in accordance with the Memoranda of Understanding between Office of Environment and Heritage these organisations regarding the regulation of vehicles and premises used to transport and store kangaroo carcasses. Information may also be exchanged with the Firearms Safety & Training Council Ltd regarding Harvester accreditation and NSW Police regarding compliance matters.

You may access and amend your personal information at any time by contacting Office of Environment and Heritage.

Public register

As required by the *Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016*, a public register of wildlife licences will be published on the Office of Environment and Heritage website. The public register will **not** include personal information of individuals (e.g. commercial harvester (kangaroo) licence number, name, postal and email address, phone number and date of birth). Information about the location of animals covered by kangaroo management licences will be restricted to kangaroo management zone.
