RE: DEVELOPMENT APPLICATION FOR EROSION PROTECTION WORKS AT OLD BAR, TAREE

Dear Sir / Madam,

A number of adjacent property owners at Old Bar are experiencing significant erosion of their properties and are keen to undertake erosion protection works. Discussions have been held with the Greater Taree City Council regarding the proposed works and they advise that due to the fact that their coastal zone management plan has not been formally adopted, that you would act as the assessment manager under section 129A of the infrastructure SEPP.

- Owners Consent (AGM minutes and Seawall Agreement as the application is for multiple properties)

- Concept Environment Management Plan

It is noted that the proposed works are to be constructed entirely within private property but that machinery access within the adjacent designated (unconstructed) crown road will be required to undertaken construction. Advice from DPI Crown Lands is that they will issue a short term licence to occupy Crown Land for the purposes of construction of Coastal Protection Works on adjoining freehold land subject to consent being granted by OEH.
