

## Office of Environment and Heritage Licence to Possess Preserved Specimens and/or Carry Out Taxidermy

Application for a biodiversity conservation licence under the *Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016* to possess preserved specimens of protected animals (including skeletal material) and/or carry out taxidermy on protected animals on either a hobby or professional basis.

**Note**: A licence may not be issued to a private person, or to a non-educational facility, to possess a specimen of a bird of prey or a threatened species, unless the applicant can demonstrate there is a legitimate and worthwhile scientific or educational justification for possessing the specimen.
