Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016

Example licence conditions

- 1. This class of biodiversity conservation licence granted under Part 2 of the *Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016* (BC Act) is subject to approval of the interstate authority related to this licence.
- 2. This licence authorises the import/export of only the specific species of native animal(s) listed above.
- 3. Where the number of a species authorised under this licence is different to the maximum number listed above, then the licensee must advise the Chief Executive Office of Environment and Heritage, in writing or by email, the relevant licence number and the actual number of that species that was moved. The advice is to be received within seven days of the movement of the animal.
- 4. This licence may be cancelled if the licensee:
 - a. has made a false statement in an application
 - b. contravenes or fails to comply with any condition or restriction attached to this licence or any dependent licences.

Note: it is an offence under the *Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016* to breach any of the conditions of this licence, issue any false receipt, make a false entry in any record, or otherwise keep a false record or provide false or misleading records or information.
