Membership

This was the final meeting for a number of Council members following the end of their appointment terms:

- Dr David Butcher, a member with scientific qualifications in areas associated with the conservation of nature
- Ms Fiona Meller, a member of an advisory committee representing the geographic spread of the reserve system
- Ms Sharon Veale, a member with qualifications in cultural heritage research
- Mr Robin Heath, a member nominated by the Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Advisory Council
- Ms Yvonne Stewart, a member with expertise and experience in Aboriginal heritage conservation (resignation).

Plans of management

Leases and licences

Council provided advice on the proposed lease for a moguls judging structure at Perisher Ski Resort, Kosciuszko National Park.
