Item 3.1 Bouddi Farm - RTL

The State Heritage Register Committee noted the paper on Bouddi Farm – Recommendation to List.

Key points noted:

- Bouddi Farm was nominated by the owners as a fine example of the work of architect Guilford Bell commissioned by the artist Russell Drysdale.
- o Bouddi Farm adjoins Bouddi National Park in Killcare Heights on the NSW Central Coast.
- There is community support for the listing as evidenced by five submissions received in support and none in opposition.

The Chair thanked Judith Coombes and Alexandra Boukouvalas for their work and presentation.

Resolution 2023-42

The State Heritage Register Committee:

- In accordance with section 33(1)(d) of the *Heritage Act 1977*, has **considered** the submissions received in response to its notice of intention to consider listing and considers the place known as Bouddi Farm at 265 The Scenic Road, Killcare Heights satisfies more than one of the approved criteria for determining whether an item is of State heritage significance, being criteria (a), (b), and (c), as detailed in the report at Tab 3.1A.
- 2. **Recommends** to the Minister, in accordance with sections 32(1) and (2) of the *Heritage Act 1977*, that the Minister **direct** the listing of the item, Bouddi Farm, 265 The Scenic Road, Killcare Heights, on the SHR, as shown in the plan at Tab 3.1C in the report.
- 3. In accordance with section 33(1)(e) of the *Heritage Act 1977*, **give notice** of its decision to persons notified under section 33(1)(a).
- 4. In accordance with section 57(2) of the *Heritage Act 1977*, **note** that the Heritage Council Standard Exemptions will apply.

Item 3.2 North Beach Wollongong curtilage amendment - RTL

The State Heritage Register Committee noted the paper on North Beach Wollongong curtilage amendment – Recommendation to List.

Key points noted:

- The subject curtilage extension seeks to include the North Wollongong Surf Life Saving Club clubhouse and environs in the existing 2005 curtilage. This is the oldest Surf Club in the Illawarra district and the oldest surviving building in the precinct.
- Approved alterations and extensions were recently completed, including some conservation and reinstatement, so the building is now in good condition. A conservation management plan for the building was prepared in 2005.
- The Surf Life Saving Club clubhouse has local heritage listing, recognition and protection.

- Wollongong City Council have been consulted on new site-specific exemptions. The site-specific exemptions will assist with ongoing day-to-day management, minor works, temporary events and non-significant fabric changes.
- The Committee noted community support for the listing was mixed and acknowledged responses from Heritage NSW on submissions received during the exhibition period.
- The Committee actively acknowledged the red-text changes in the Statement of Significance, including the addition of State social significance.

Resolution 2023-43

The State Heritage Register Committee:

- In accordance with section 33(1)(d) of the *Heritage Act 1977*, has **considered** the submissions received in response to its notice of intention to consider listing at Tab 3.2E and considers the item known as North Beach Precinct (SHR 01737) adjoining Cliff Street and George Hanley Drive, North Wollongong, satisfies more than one of the approved criteria for determining whether an item is of State heritage significance, being criteria (a), (c), (d), (e), (f) and (g) as detailed in the report at Tab 3.2A.
- 2. **Recommends** to the Minister, in accordance with sections 32(1) and (2) of the *Heritage Act 1977*, that the Minister **direct** the curtilage extension of the listing, North Beach Precinct, Cliff Road, Wollongong, on the SHR, as shown in the plan at Tab 3.2C.
- 3. In accordance with section 33(1)(e) of the *Heritage Act 1977*, will **give notice** of its decision to persons notified under section 33(1)(a).
- 4. In accordance with section 57(2) of the *Heritage Act 1977*, **recommends** that the Minister **grant** the site specific exemptions at Tab 3.2H of the report.
