## **Item 1.1 The Powerhouse Ultimo Project**

The Heritage Council of NSW received a briefing from Powerhouse and their consultants on the revised design scheme and revitalisation plan for the Powerhouse Ultimo Project.

The Powerhouse provided an overview of the revitalisation works that aim to address the fabric deterioration of the built form and respond to the operational challenges faced by the museum, as well as opportunities for a state-of-the-art facility into the future.

The timeline for revitalisation and the current design scheme were presented.

The consultant team is engaging with Heritage NSW to work through the approach to tangible and intangible heritage, the proposed expansion of the SHR curtilage including site specific exemptions, and potential updates to the conservation management plan.

The Council thanked the Powerhouse for the presentation and noted that further discussions will take place at the March meeting.
