Draft Code of Practice for Keeping Native Frogs

Section 6. Enclosure Furnishing > 6.1 Substrate > Notes

Similar to how the minimum standard for enclosure sizes was done for large, medium and small frogs, a variation in substrate depth for burrowing frogs would be appreciated as some people might have substrate that is too shallow to dig in, or too deep that the frog might get stuck in an attempt to get to the surface.

Other than the substrate thing, there isn't anything else I thought should be changed. The whole thing is very informative and extremely helpful to beginner keepers.

Draft Code of Practice for Keeping Native Reptiles

Section 3. Enclosure Construction > 3.4 Dangerous Reptiles > 3.4.1 Standards > 3.4.1.5
