NOTICE OF A PROPOSED LICENCE TO DODGER SPV PTY LTD FOR USE OF A PART OF CALLAN PARK

Proposed licence of part of buildings 26 & 27 (Kirkbride) and part of the Kirkbride courtyard to Dodger SPV Pty Ltd for a commercial film production

Pursuant to section 6(6) of the *Callan Park (Special Provisions) Act 2002 (NSW)* (the Act) notice is given of a proposal to Licence of buildings 26 & 27 (Kirkbride) and part of the Kirkbride courtyard in Callan Park.

As the consent authority, the Minister for Infrastructure, Cities and Active Transport would like to consider any written comments regarding the proposed Licence in accordance with section 6 of the Act.

The main terms of the proposed Licence are as follows:

- The licence is for commercial filming wholly within the Kirkbride Precinct, within Building 29 and Building 27, and in the Northern and Central courtyard areas.
- The licence will be issued by the Centennial Park and Moore Park Trust (CPMPT). The licence agreement is between Health Administration Corporation and Dodger SPV Pty Ltd (Dodger).
- A licence fee is agreed between the parties, and revenue generated will be reinvested in the Kirkbride Precinct for ongoing and essential maintenance and compliance works.
- The Licence will be executed to commence on 21 November 2022 and expire on 23 April 2023.
