NOTICE OF THE MINISTER'S DECISION TO GRANT CONSENT FOR A LICENCE TO DODGER SPV PTY LTD FOR USE OF A PART OF CALLAN PARK

Pursuant to section 6(6) of the *Callan Park (Special Provisions) Act 2002 (NSW)* (the Act) the Minister for Infrastructure, Cities and Active Transport, notice is given that consent has been granted to a Licence of buildings 26 & 27 (Kirkbride) and part of the Kirkbride courtyard in Callan Park to Dodger SPV Pty Ltd.

The Minister has considered comments regarding the proposed Licence in accordance with Section 6 and 6(6A) of the Act and has granted consent for the following reasons:

- HAC, the landowner, has requested that the Department of Transport facilitate the licence
- The licence has been appropriately advertised in accordance with Section 6(6) and 6(6A) of the Act
- The advertisement received two submissions, neither of which objected to the proposed licence. Comments made have been considered in determining whether to grant consent to the licence
- The licence is for commercial filming wholly within Kirkbride precinct, Buildings 27 and 29, and in the Northern and Central courtyard areas
- The licence agreement is between HAC and Dodger SPV Pty Ltd who have agreed the terms of the licence, including a licence fee which will be reinvested in the Kirkbride precinct for ongoing and essential maintenance and compliance works
- The licensee is bound by the terms and conditions of the licence which uphold the exceptional heritage values of the Kirkbride site. The licensee has been provided copies of the Conservation Management Plans for Callan Park and Kirkbride, and other heritage documentation and must abide by legislation that applies with respect to the Kirkbride Complex
- NSW Health representatives will monitor adherence to, and ensure compliance with, the conditions of the licence
- The licence will be executed to commence on 21 November 2022 and conclude on 23 April 2023.
