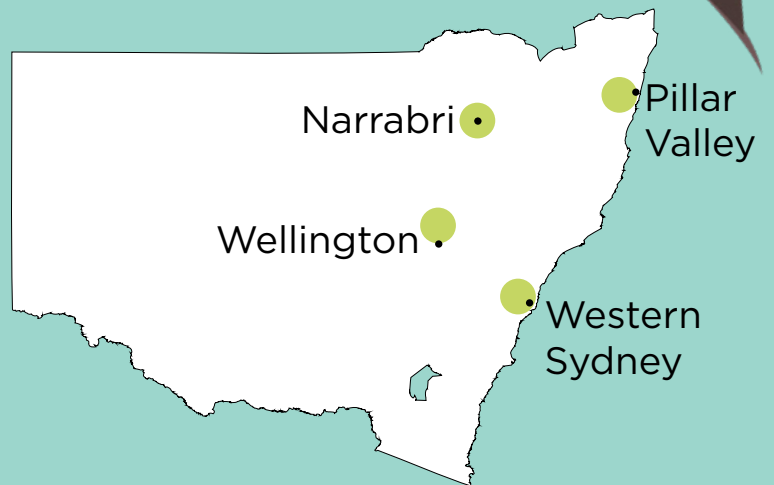
The most commonly recorded species was Gould's wattled bat (*Chalinolobus gouldii*) recorded at

**96 out of 108 sites**

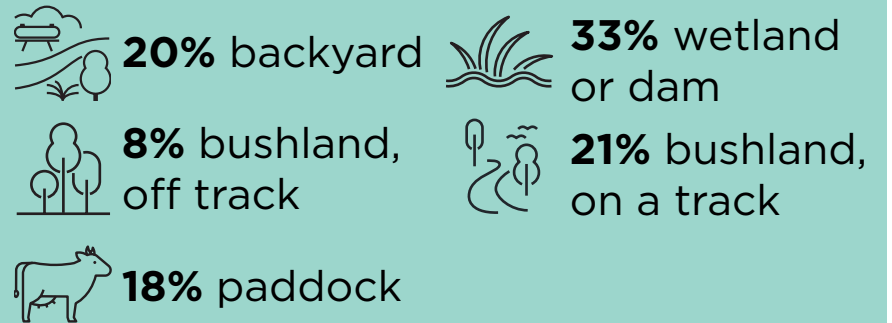
**24 species recorded**

Of 34 insectivorous bat species in NSW

**17** are **threatened**

**1** thought to be **extinct**

**9 threatened species recorded**, including:

- Large bent-winged bat (*Miniopterus orianae oceanensis*)
- Yellow-bellied sheath-tail-bat (*Saccolaimus flaviventris*)
- Little pied bat (*Chalinolobus picatus*)
