

The most commonly recorded species was Gould's wattled bat (*Chalinolobus gouldii*) recorded at

96 out of 108 sites

24 species recorded





Of 34 insectivorous bat species in NSW

7 are threatened

thought to be extinct

9 threatened species recorded, including:

- Large bent-winged bat (Miniopterus orianae oceanensis)
- Yellow-bellied sheathtail-bat (Saccolaimus flaviventris)
- Little pied bat (Chalinolobus picatus)
