# **Declared Aboriginal Places in NSW**

### Note: this table will be updated from time to time, please ensure that you refer to the most recent version

Under section 90 of the *National Parks and Wildlife* Act, 1974, it is an offence to damage, deface or destroy and Aboriginal place without consent (i.e. a s.90 Aboriginal Heritage Impact permit). The potential impacts of the development on an Aboriginal place must be assessed if the development will be in the vicinity of an Aboriginal place.

The following table provides a mid-point for each declared Aboriginal place in NSW, as at 15 October 2009. If a development site will be located within the relevant buffer distance of any of these points (listed in the third last column of the table below - 4 km in most cases), the proponent **must**:

- refer to the gazettal notice for details, and/or
- contact the Department of Environment, Climate Change and Water (DECCW) for more detailed information.

Please note that specific eastings and northings have not been provided for a two Aboriginal places, which are culturally sensitive sites. Local landmarks are provided for reference. If the development's location in relation to these landmarks is unclear, proponents should contact DECCW for assistance.
