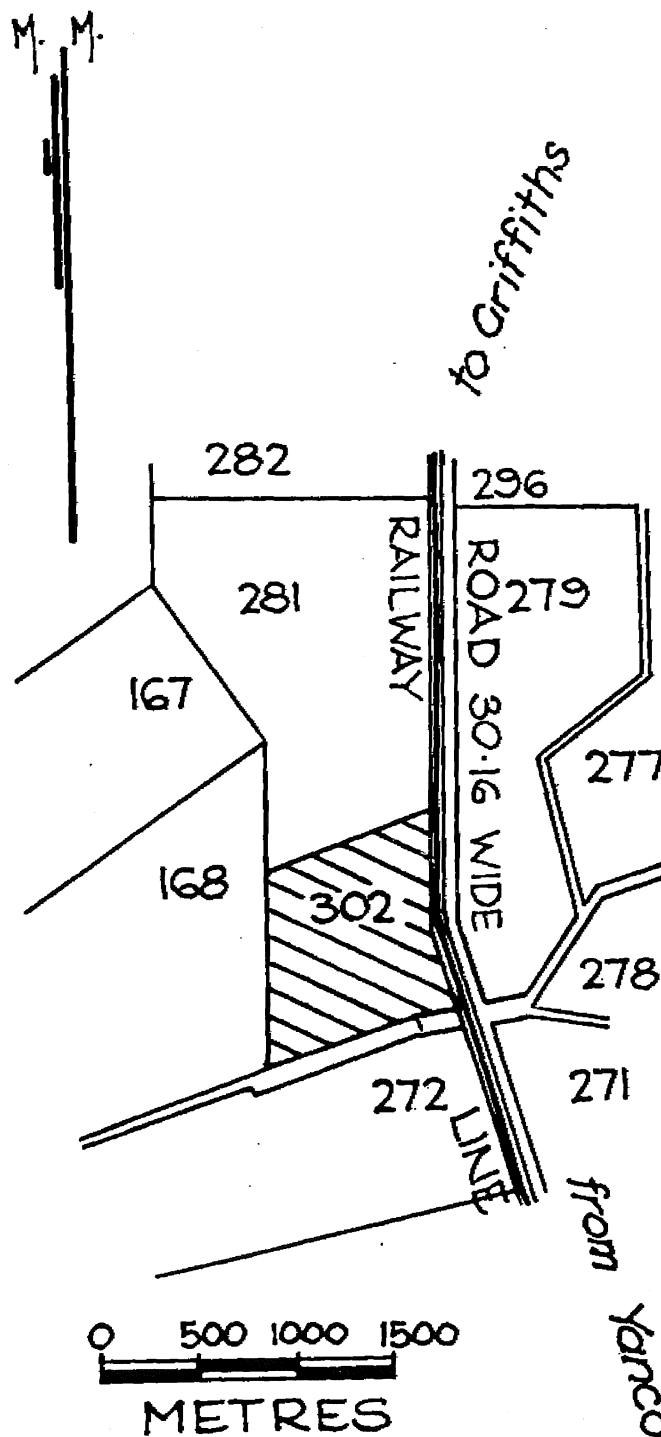

Development Application by the Housing Commission of New South Wales for proposed clay/shale extraction from Housing Commission Site 7770 at Mulgoa, Penrith

NOTICE is hereby given that the Minister for Planning and Environment, pursuant to section 119 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act, 1979, has directed that a public inquiry be held by Commissioners of Inquiry appointed under section 119 (2) of that Act to consider and make recommendations upon the development application described above. Pursuant to section 119 (2) the Minister has appointed Mr John Woodward, Chairman, and Dr Alan Gilpin, Commissioners of Inquiry, to constitute a Commission of Inquiry.

Any person may, before the commencement of the public inquiry, inspect the development application and documents accompanying the application, by appointment at the Office of the Commissioners of Inquiry, Level 13, Wynyard House, 291 George Street, Sydney.

The Inquiry will be conducted in four sessions as follows:

- (i) Preliminary matters and applications by parties;
- (ii) Primary submissions;
- (iii) Questions and answers;
- (iv) Submissions in reply.

Persons seeking to make submissions to the Inquiry are required to register by lodgment of a primary submission, in writing, at the City of Penrith Council Chambers, corner Station and Henry Streets, Penrith, on Tuesday, 6th December, 1983, at 9 a.m.

The Inquiry will commence at the City of Penrith Council Chambers at 9.30 a.m. on Tuesday, 6th December, 1983, and will continue as required.

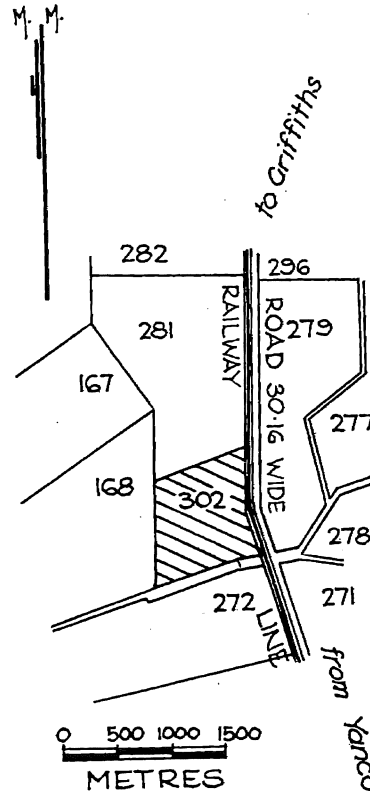

FISHERIES AND OYSTER FARMS ACT, 1935

SECTION 18 NOTIFICATION—FISHING CLOSURE

PURSUANT to section 18 of the Fisheries and Oyster Farms Act, 1935, I, JACK ROWLAND HALLAM, Minister for Agriculture and Fisheries, do, by this my Notification, vary the Proclamation dated 26th January, 1977, and published in Government Gazette No. 18 of 18th February, 1977, prohibiting the taking of certain fish by any means whatsoever from the tidal waters of New South Wales until 31st December, 1985 by omitting "and elegant wrasse (*Anampses elegans*)" and by inserting in lieu thereof "elegant wrasse (*Anampses elegans*)" and Black Cod (*Epinephelus daemeli*)".
