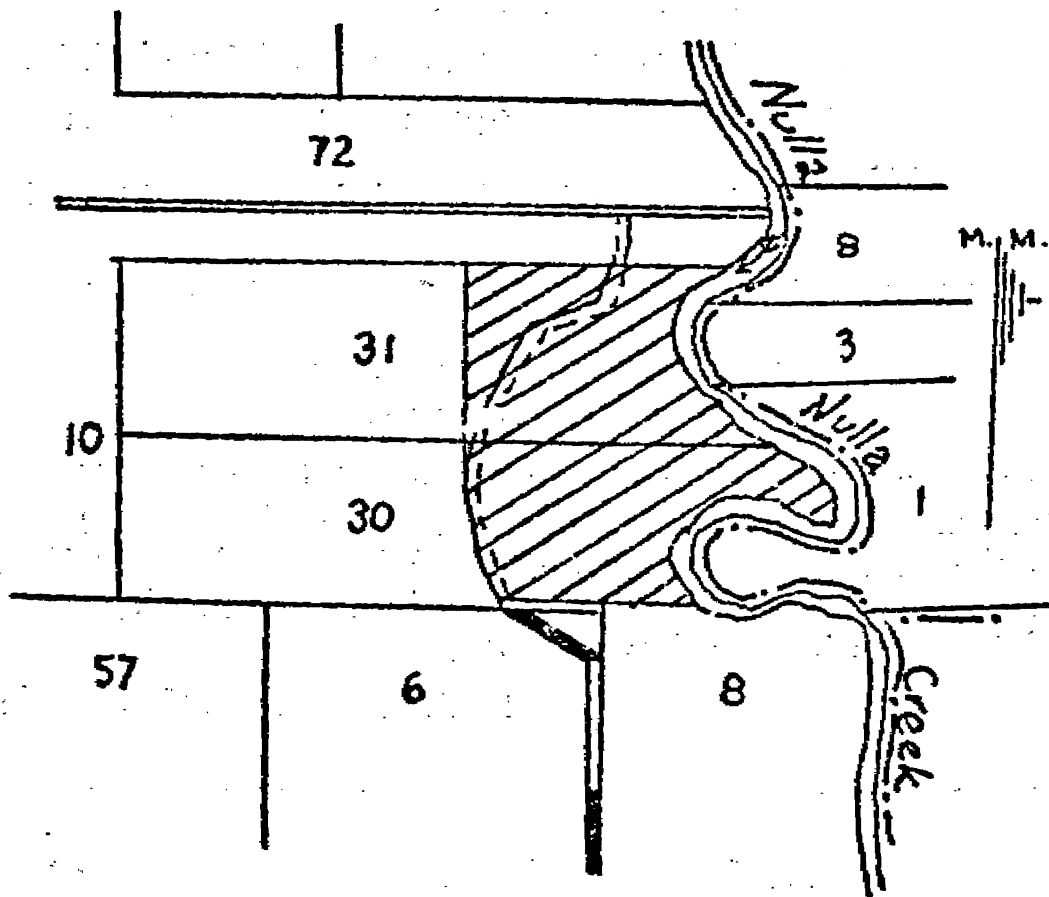

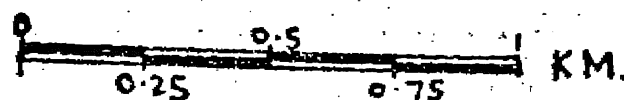
Description

PIPELINES ACT, 1967

1. "Chicco" teething ring, identified in the manufacturer's catalogue by the number 51.
2. "Tommee Tippee" rattle, identified in the manufacturer's catalogue as TT 220.
3. A baby's soother, being a baby's "dummy" or "pacifier", without a safety shield, consisting of a pink rubber bulbous teat, of 30 mm in maximum diameter, attached to a yellow whistle which sounds as the baby sucks on the teat. (7748)

ANTI-DISCRIMINATION ACT, 1977

EXEMPTION ORDER UNDER SECTION 126

I, NEVILLE KENNETH WRAN, Premier, on the recommendation of the Anti-Discrimination Board, hereby grant an exemption from the provisions of section 25 (2) (a) and (b) of the Anti-Discrimination Act, 1977, in respect of the practice of the Director-General of Education of preferring women for appointment as principals of girls' high schools and preferring men for appointment as principals of boys' high schools.

This exemption shall remain in force for a period of five years from the date hereof.

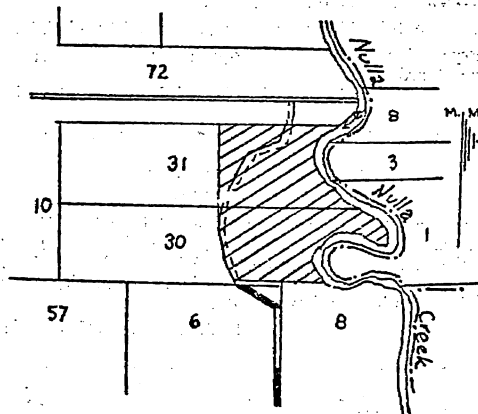
