Heritage Act 1977

Criteria for listing on the State Heritage Register

The State Heritage Register is established under Part 3A of the Heritage Act (as amended in 1998) for listing of items of environmental heritage¹ which are of state heritage significance².

To be assessed for listing on the State Heritage Register an item will, in the opinion of the Heritage Council of NSW, meet one or more of the following criteria³:

- a) an item is important in the course, or pattern, of NSW's cultural or natural history;
- b) an item has strong or special association with the life or works of a person, or group of persons, of importance in NSW's cultural or natural history;
- c) an item is important in demonstrating aesthetic characteristics and/or a high degree of creative or technical achievement in NSW;
- d) an item has strong or special association with a particular community or cultural group in NSW for social, cultural or spiritual reasons;
- e) an item has potential to yield information that will contribute to an understanding of NSW's cultural or natural history;
- f) an item possesses uncommon, rare or endangered aspects of NSW's cultural or natural history;
- g) an item is important in demonstrating the principal characteristics of a class of NSW's
 - cultural or natural places; or
 - cultural or natural environments.

An item is not to be excluded from the Register on the ground that items with similar characteristics have already been listed on the Register.

¹ **environmental heritage** means those places, buildings, works, relics, moveable objects, and precincts, of state or local heritage significance (section 4, *Heritage Act, 1977*).

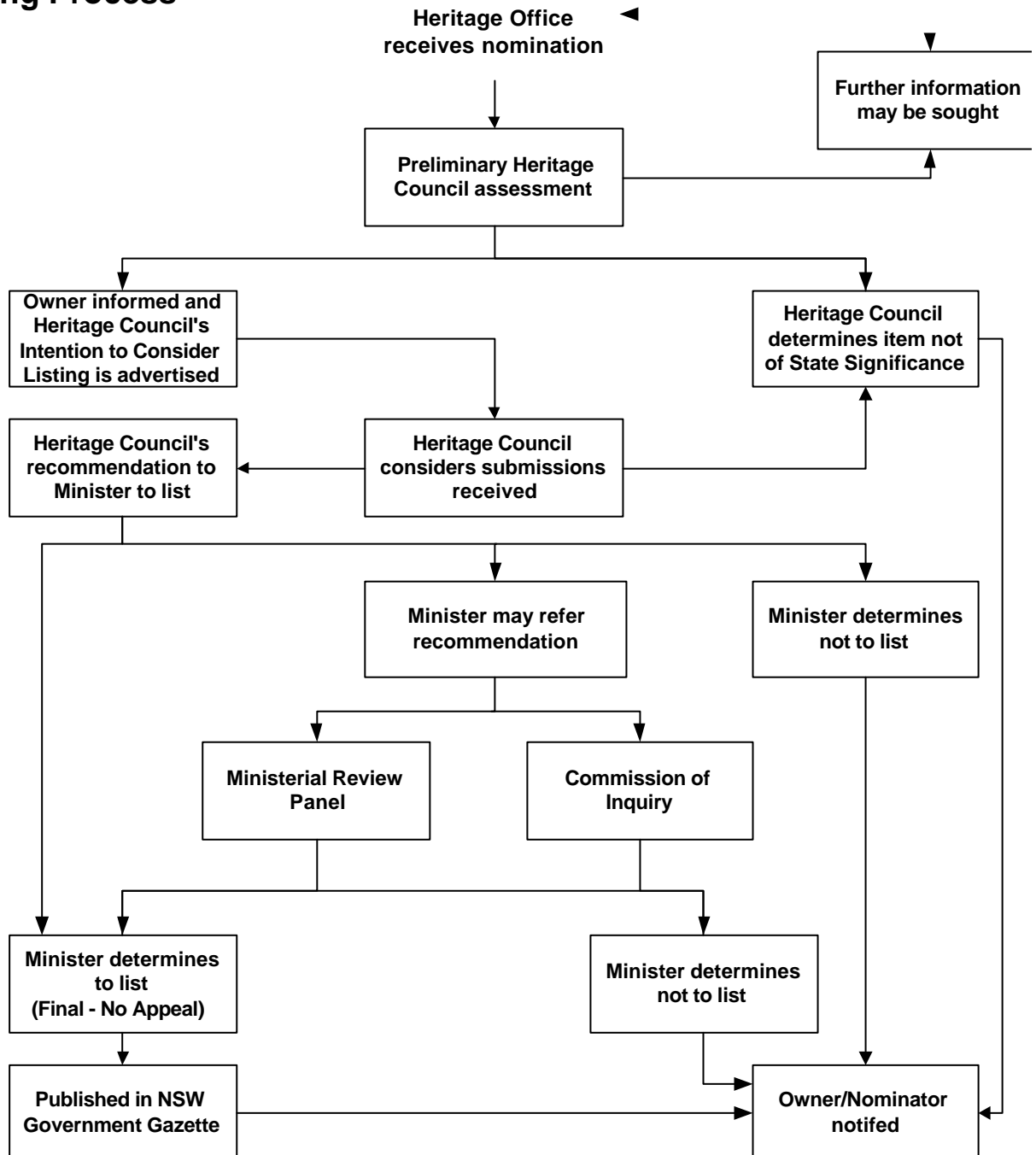
² **state heritage significance**, in relation to a place, building, work, relic, moveable object or precinct, means significance to the State in relation to the historical, scientific cultural, social, archaeological, architectural, natural or aesthetic value of the item (section 4A(1), *Heritage Act, 1977*).

World War II Aerodromes and Landing Grounds in NSW

Below is a list of all known World War II RAAF aerodromes and landing grounds in the State of New South Wales. They are listed alphabetically within the historical region they belong.⁴ It should be noted that civil aerodromes, emergency landing grounds and flying boat bases are not included.⁵

The name in brackets after the aerodrome name denotes the 'parent', eg Bringelly (Fleur), Liverpool City Council. This means Bringelly is a satellite aerodrome of Fleur in the local government area of Liverpool - Fleur being the 'parent' aerodrome. Some aerodromes are without any reference in brackets indicating that they were not attached to a 'parent'.

Appendix G

Table 1 includes additional information to that provided in Table 2, primarily because the information was gleaned from the draft SHI forms. Additional headings are: Pre-war Status; Construction Date; and Post-war Status.

Definition of headings in the Tables are defined as follows:

- USE - Principal Former Function (operational, training, maintenance)
- CLASS. - Classification (additional information relating to its principal function)
- LAT/LONG - Location (latitude and longitude)
- CONST. DATE - Construction Date
- REMARKS - Status of runway etc (measurements are given in feet)

A glossary of abbreviations used in these tables is provided at the end.

NB: in some instances, an aerodrome may have had more than one site and use. When this is the case, a major activity denotes its principal former function. For example, Richmond is a parent and had two functions: Aircraft Depot (AD) and Licensed Public Airfield Class 'C' (LPA C) (refer SHI Form). Due to its AD status it is listed in Table 1 under Training.
