JULY 1999

That the Heritage Council State Heritage Register Committee as delegate of the Heritage Council:

- advises the Minister that the Victoria Theatre, 8-10 Perkins Street, Newcastle is an item of State heritage significance; and
- recommends to the Minister that the Victoria Theatre, 8-10 Perkins Street, Newcastle be listed on the State Heritage Register.

- advises the Minister that the Yiu Ming Temple, Retreat Street, Alexandria is an item of State heritage significance; and
- recommends to the Minister that the Yiu Ming Temple, Retreat Street, Alexandria be listed on the State Heritage Register.

- advises the Minister that the Chinese Market Gardens, Bunnerong Road, La Perouse is an item of State heritage significance; and
- recommends to the Minister that the Chinese Market Gardens, Bunnerong Road, La Perouse be listed on the State Heritage Register.

- advises the Minister that Epping Forest, Mississippi Crescent, Kearns is an item of State heritage significance; and
- recommends to the Minister that Epping Forest, Mississippi Crescent, Kearns be listed on the State Heritage Register.

- advises the Minister that Babworth House, 103 Darling Point Road, Darling Point is an item of State heritage significance; and
- recommends to the Minister that Babworth House, 103 Darling Point Road, Darling Point be listed on the State Heritage Register.

- advises the Minister that the Maitland Post Office, Armidale Post Office, Mudgee Post Office, Albury Post Office, Tenterfield Post Office are items of State significance;
- recommends to the Minister that the Maitland Post Office 381 High Street Maitland, Armidale Post Office 158 Beardy Street Armidale, Mudgee Post Office 80 Market Street Mudgee, Albury Post Office 570 Dean Street Albury and Tenterfield Post Office 207 Rouse Street Tenterfield be listed on the State Heritage Register;

- recommends that the Minister revoke Interim Conservation Order No. 942 in respect of the property at 28 Monash Street, Wentworthville.

- recommends to the Minister that the Como Hotel, 15-41, Cremona Road, Como (SHR No. 437) be removed from the State Heritage Register.
- recommends to the Minister that Pangas House, 15-17, Hunter Street, Sydney (SHR No. 704) be removed from the State Heritage Register.
- recommends to the Minister that he place an Interim Heritage Order over Old Bar Airstrip and appropriate curtilages to provide time for the intention to consider listing, as required under the Act, to be completed.

AUGUST 1999

That the Heritage Council

- recommend to the Minister, pursuant to Section 106 of the Heritage Act, the approval of the funding of 314 projects comprising:
 - i. 226 applications under the Heritage Assistance Program totalling \$1,339,555;
 - ii. 35 new *Heritage 2001* projects totalling \$1,195,300; and
 - iii. 53 *Heritage 2001* year 2 and 3 projects totalling \$2,075,700.

That the Heritage Council State Heritage Register Committee as delegate of the Heritage Council:

- advises the Minister that Broughton House, 43a Thomas Street, North Parramatta, is an item of State heritage significance; and
- recommends to the Minister that Broughton House, 43a Thomas Street, North Parramatta be listed on the State Heritage Register.
- advises the Minister that Christ Church, King Street, Bungonia is an item of State heritage significance; and
- recommends to the Minister that Christ Church, King Street, Bungonia be listed on the State Heritage Register.
- recommends the Minister makes an Interim Heritage Order over 260 Johnston Street, Annandale, which is part of the Witches House Precinct; and
- notes that Willeroon, 35 Ocean Rd, Palm Beach is an important contributing element in the Ocean Road Conservation Area, and listed in Local Environmental Plan 1993 (Amendment No 32) heritage conservation;
- rescinds its resolution 15 April 1999 which recommended to the Minister the making of an IHO over Willeroon; and
- notes it is an heritage item of local significance and should be listed as an individual item in the heritage schedule of Pittwater LEP.

SEPTEMBER 1999

That the Heritage Council State Heritage Register Committee as delegate of the Heritage Council:

- advises the Minister that Joadja is an item of State heritage significance; and
- recommends to the Minister that Joadja be listed on the State Heritage Register;

- advises the Minister that the jetty, boatshed, well and foreshore land associated with Mulholland's Farm are of State heritage significance; and
- recommends to the Minister that these elements associated with Mulholland's Farm (SHR No 289) be listed on the State Heritage Register; and

- advises the Minister that Old Bar Airfield, Old Bar is an item of State heritage significance; and
- recommends to the Minister that Old Bar Airfield, Old Bar (as shown in Annexure B), be listed on the State Heritage Register;

- advises the Minister that the Wing Hing Long & Co. Store, 10 Ruby Street, Tingha is an item of State heritage significance; and
- recommends to the Minister that the Wing Hing Long & Co. Store, 10 Ruby Street, Tingha be listed on the State Heritage Register.

- recommends the Minister makes an Interim Heritage Order over 15, 17 and 57 Cremorne Road, Cremorne;

- recommends the Minister makes an Interim Heritage Order over New England Brass and Iron Lace Foundry, Uralla.

OCTOBER 1999

That the Heritage Council recommend to the Minister, pursuant to section 106 of the Heritage Act, 1977, the approval of:

- seventeen grants totalling \$171,884 for Aboriginal heritage projects. (In respect of HAP 342, 1938 Day of Mourning and Protest, funding is approved subject to finalisation to the decision regarding the administrative body.);

- six grants to the National Trust totalling \$191,000;

That the Heritage Council:

- recommend to the Minister that the Ministerial Order: *Authorisations for local councils to make Interim Heritage Orders* be signed and gazetted;

- advises the minister of its disappointment in the delay of the World Heritage Nomination;

That the Heritage Council State Heritage Register Committee as delegate of the Heritage Council:

- advises the Minister that Susannah Place, 58-64 Gloucester Street, The Rocks is an item of State heritage significance; and
- recommends to the Minister that Susannah Place, 58-64 Gloucester Street, The Rocks be listed on the State Heritage Register;

- advises the Minister that First Government House Site, Bridge Street, Sydney is an item of State heritage significance; and
- recommends to the Minister that First Government House Site, Bridge Street, Sydney be listed on the State Heritage Register;

- advises the Minister that the Amusu Theatre, 17 Delowie Street, Manildra is an item of State heritage significance; and
- recommends to the Minister Amusu Theatre, 17 Delowie Street, Manildra be listed on the State Heritage Register.

- advises the Minister pursuant to section 136(4) of the *Heritage Act 1977* that 17 Abercorn Street, Bexley (house) is of significance to the City of Rockdale, and should be listed as a heritage item in the Rockdale LEP;
- the section 136 order voids the development consent granted by Rockdale City Council;
- the owners have accepted an offer by the Heritage Office to fund drafting of new plans for an option which would retain the cottage;
- recommends the Minister makes an Interim Heritage Order; and
- that the making of an Interim Heritage Order be deferred pending the outcome of Resolutions 1 and 2;
- it is further recommended that the Minister write to Rockdale City Council advising it that the Heritage Council has advised him that the cottage is of significance to the City of Rockdale and requests the City Council:
 - i) immediately commence preparing a draft LEP to list the cottage as a heritage item;
 - ii) assist the owner and the Heritage Office to implement a development option which would retain and conserve the cottage in a sympathetic setting; and
 - iii) expedite completion of its heritage planning to ensure that the heritage resource of the area is identified and conserved;

- recommends to the Minister that an Interim Heritage Order (IHO) be made over the Nos 29, 31, 33, 35, 37 & 39 Morehead Street, Redfern, and No. 2 Little Young Street, Redfern, in recognition of their heritage significance;

- concludes that Moore Park and Centennial Park parklands are of State heritage significance and should be listed on the State Heritage Register;
 - defers giving public notice of its intention to consider the listing of the parklands on the State Heritage Register pending the outcome of discussions on 28 October 1999 with the Centennial Park and Moore Park Trust about such a listing and about management issues including appropriate exemptions;
 - recommends that the Minister make an Interim Heritage Order over the Old Grand Drive and its curtilage which the Minister considers may, on further inquiry or investigation, be found to be of State or local heritage significance; and
 - defers acting on the Interim Heritage Order recommendation pending the outcome of discussions with the Centennial Park and Moore Park Trust, on the basis that the Director, Heritage Office, may implement this recommendation if urgent action is necessary;
- recommends that the Minister make an Interim Heritage Order over the North West County Council Building, Inverell, which the Minister considers may, on further inquiry or investigation, be found to be of State or local heritage significance; and
 - advises all relevant parties that in the event an Interim Heritage Order is made, the Heritage Council becomes the consent authority for a period of 12 months and could only consider future applications under section 60 that are accompanied by a comprehensive heritage assessment and heritage impact statement.

NOVEMBER 1999

That the Heritage Council State Heritage Register Committee as delegate of the Heritage Council:

- recommend to the Minister that an Interim Heritage Order be made over Hilderlea, 7 Commonwealth Parade, Manly, which the Minister considers may, on further investigation, be found to be of State or local heritage significance;
- recommend that the Minister make an Interim Heritage Order over Highbury, 165 High Street, Kirribilli, which the Minister considers may, on further inquiry or investigation, be found to be of State or local heritage significance.

DECEMBER 1999

That the Heritage Council recommend to the Minister that

- clause 63(2) be amended so that the Heritage Council has the power to approve the demolition of the whole of a building or work where:

APPENDIX G

MANAGEMENT OF THE HERITAGE OFFICE

Director

Rosalind Strong has been the Director of the Heritage Office since its establishment in July 1996 and has led the Office in the implementation of the NSW Government Heritage Policy. This has included significant amendments to the *NSW Heritage Act 1977*. Mrs Strong's previous position was Assistant Director-General in the Department of Training and Education Co-ordination, responsible for adult education and vocational training. Mrs Strong has raised the profile of heritage across government, in schools and within local communities. Her long involvement in migrant and multicultural education has also proved invaluable in widening the focus of the Heritage Council and the Heritage Office in relation to the diversity of the State's heritage. She became a member of the Heritage Council in 1996.

CEO Performance Statement

Mrs Strong is the Heritage Office's only SES officer. The Minister for Urban Affairs and Planning has indicated his satisfaction with Mrs Strong's performance throughout the reporting period with regard to the following specific responsibilities:

- knowledge of NSW heritage, its significance and conservation
- government leadership in heritage management
- local heritage management
- value of heritage to the community
- conservation practice standards
- role and functions of the Heritage Council
- support to the Minister and Heritage Council
- development of the Heritage Office and its staff.

Assistant Director

In July 1998 Reece McDougall commenced as Assistant Director of the Heritage Office. Mr McDougall began his career as a ranger with the NSW Forestry Commission, and was later a research officer with the National Trust for six years. He moved from the Trust to the Sydney Water Board as a senior environmental scientist and later became principal consultant with AWT Ensight, the commercial arm of the Sydney Water Corporation.

Mr McDougall's key role is to co-ordinate and supervise the work of the Principal Heritage Officers in reaching the targets of the strategic plan.

Principal Heritage Officer Positions

As a response to the strategic plan's focus on the principal client groups of community, local government and State government/Commonwealth, three principal heritage officer positions were created in 1998. These positions are filled as follows:

Murray Brown (Principal Heritage Officer, Heritage Promotion & Community Education) has a varied media and arts background. He was a project officer with the Australian Film Commission for a number of years and was the chief executive of the Confederation of Professional Performing Arts and Arts Training Australia before his appointment as a consultant to the Department of Urban Affairs and Planning in 1993.

Ian Kelly (Principal Heritage Officer, State and Commonwealth Heritage Management) trained as an architect and has worked in architectural practices in Australia and overseas. After lecturing at the Curtin University of Technology in Perth in architectural design, history and conservation he worked at the Heritage Council of Western Australia, before joining the NSW Heritage Office as acting senior heritage officer in February 1997.

Susan Macdonald (Principal Heritage Officer, Local Government Heritage Management) trained and practised as an architect in Sydney before moving to England to work on private and government conservation projects for ten years. Before joining the Heritage Office she was a member of the architectural conservation team with English Heritage for four years.

During the year **Vincent Sicari** was appointed to the key role of Senior Heritage Officer, Local Government Heritage Management. He was with the Heritage Group of the Department of Public Works and Services from 1987 to his new appointment. Vincent has been the conservation architect for the St Mary's Cathedral conservation project since 1993. He has a special interest in heritage and local government, and was a councillor for four years. He worked at the Royal Institute of British Architects in London for two years and has wide links in conservation throughout Italy and Spain.
