

2008-2009 NSW Heritage Grants program

The one year 2008-2009 NSW Heritage Grants funding program was completed in 2008-2009. The NSW Treasury budget allocation of \$2.662 million was fully expended for the 2008-2009 financial year.

2006-2008 Heritage Incentives Program

The second year of the two year 2006-2008 Heritage Incentives Program was completed in 2007-2008. The NSW Treasury budget allocation of \$2.635 million was fully expended for the 2007-2008 financial year.

2008-2009 NSW Heritage Grants program

The one year 2008-2009 NSW Heritage Grants program was launched in September 2007 with applications opening for the Works, Interpretation and Community Strategic Projects Programs.

A Special Program for Major Cultural and Community Heritage Buildings to be jointly funded with Arts NSW has been recommended to the Minister for Planning for inclusion in the 2008-2009 NSW Heritage Grants program. This has necessitated the withdrawal of three previously advertised programs, namely: the Conservation Documents and Management Reports program; the Heritage Advice and Cash Back program and the Special Grants Program.
