

2008-2009 NSW Heritage Grants program

The one year 2008-2009 NSW Heritage Grants funding program was completed in 2008-2009. The NSW Treasury budget allocation of \$2.662 million was fully expended for the 2008-2009 financial year.

2009-2011 NSW Heritage Grants program

The two year 2009-2011 NSW Heritage Grants program was launched in October 2008 with competitive applications opening for the following programs at this time: Works; Interpretation; Community Strategic products and services projects; and the Special Program for Major Cultural and Community Heritage Buildings program. Applications for all other programs were open throughout the year for the following programs: Kick Start fund raising; Local government heritage management; and Aboriginal heritage projects.
