

Catch and release possum licence Application form

A biodiversity conservation licence

Complete this form and send with the <u>fee to apply</u> for a non-site specific Catch and release possum licence under the *Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016*. This licence is generally issued to commercial operators and allows authorised person(s) listed on the licence to harm (catch and release) possums – brushtail possum (*Trichosurus vulpecula*), ringtail possum (*Pseudocheirus peregrinus*) and bobuck (*Trichosurus caninus*), using cage traps for the sole purpose of removal from premises.

The applicant is required to:

- Ensure administrative tasks are complete and submitted as required, including application details, record keeping, reporting and notifying National Parks and Wildlife Service of any changes to information provided in this application
- Check the details entered in section 5 for each person nominated for authority to harm (catch and release). Submit details if an applicant or nominee has answered 'yes' to Q1 and /or Q2 in sections 3 and/or 5.
- Complete section 6 if an authorised person is no longer required on a licence.
- Send the fee for new or renewed licences with this completed application for assessment to begin.

Licences to control or harm animals, other than the removal of possums from premises

To control animals for purposes other than removal of possums from premises, contact the <u>local National Parks</u> <u>and Wildlife office</u>. A biodiversity conservation licence under the *Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016* is required to <u>control or harm animals</u>.

Other statutory requirements

All authorised persons must comply with other statutory or regulatory provisions relevant to this licence such local council requirements and *Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act 1979*.

Privacy statement

This application form requests information that identifies you and is defined as 'personal information' under the NSW Privacy and Personal Information Act 1998. Information supplied on this form will be used by delegated officers of the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment to assess your application and will be entered into a computer system for granting licences. You may access and amend your personal information at any time by contacting the Department.

Public register

As required by the *Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016*, a public register of biodiversity conservation licences is published on the Department website. The public register does not include personal information of individuals (e.g. name, postal and email address, phone number and date of birth). Information about the location of plants and animals covered by licences will be restricted to postcode.

Application processing

See the <u>Wildlife licence fee payment and schedule</u>. If you prefer to pay by credit card, use the credit card payment details slip on the form. If you prefer to pay by cheque or money order make it payable to 'The Department of Planning, Industry and Environment' and post to the address below. It can take up to 28 days to process a licence. If an application is withdrawn prior to a decision being made on the licence application a refund may be payable. No refund is payable once a licence is granted.

Nominated persons

Each person nominated for authority to harm (catch and release) must:

- a. Provide their name and date of birth to be submitted as part of the application.
- b. Read Q1and Q2, then tick the 'yes' box in the table to confirm it has been read.
 - Q1. Have you been investigated or convicted of an offence in the last 10 years in relation to any law concerning the protection, conservation or management of native species or ecological communities? If yes, provide detail with the application.
 - Q2. Have you had a biodiversity conservation licence or similar permit suspended or cancelled? If yes, provide detail with the application.
- c. Read the following declaration and sign in the space provided in the table to agree if the information provided is true and correct.

Declaration

I, the nominated person for authority to harm (catch and release) possums for the sole purpose of removal from premises, acknowledge that it is an offence under the *Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016* to provide false or misleading information in, or in connection with this application and I state the information I have provided is true and correct.
