Item 2. Legal, Policy & Administration

Item 2.1 2025-28 Heritage Council Strategic Plan and NSW Heritage Strategy

The Heritage Council of NSW reviewed the draft 2025-28 strategic priorities framework prepared by Heritage NSW following the Heritage Council's strategic planning workshop held 6 May 2025.

Members provided feedback on the draft framework which is aligned with the draft NSW Heritage Strategy and discussed the next steps, including development of a measurable delivery plan with identified actions and activities for implementation.

Heritage NSW provided an update on the draft NSW Heritage Strategy that is on public exhibition until 13 July 2025 and open for community feedback via the *Have Your Say* webpage.

Item 2.2 Heritage Council self-assessment

The Heritage Council of NSW received a report from Heritage NSW and provided feedback on the draft self-assessment framework prepared for the Council's periodic review of its performance and effectiveness.

Item 3.1 St Mary's (SHR 017090) - LEC Class 1 proceedings - update

The Heritage Council received a verbal update from the Chair and Dr Brunton regarding the Class 1 Land and Environment Court proceedings underway for *St Mary's Precinct*, Sydney.

Item 3.2 Updates to heritage asset management guidelines: Heritage Council guidelines for state agencies

The Heritage Council of NSW received a report from Heritage NSW seeking approval to amend the 2024 *Heritage asset management guidelines* for state agencies.

Members discussed the opportunity to amend the guidelines to provide greater clarity around State Heritage Register (SHR) listed assets or assets identified as having state significance on heritage and conservation registers.

These assets may require referral to the Heritage Council for comment and are subjected to longer notification periods than assets with local heritage significance.

Resolution 2025-28

The Heritage Council of NSW resolved to:

1. **Approve** a minor addition to section 7.2 of the 2024 *Heritage asset management guidelines* (as set out in Tab 3.2B of the report), to clarify that the Heritage Council may wish to comment on government instrumentality proposals that remove occupation or demolition of State significant heritage assets.
