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



Fire Thresholds	
Overburn	Fire thresholds have been exceeded. Protect from fire as far as possible.
Vulnerable	The area will be Overburn if this year. Protect from fire as far as possible.
Recently Burnt	Time since fire is less than the optimum interval, but before that it was within threshold. Avoid fires if possible.
Within Threshold	Fire history is within the threshold for vegetation in this area. A burn is neither required nor should one necessarily be avoided.
Almost Underburnt	A prescribed burn may be advantageous. Consider allowing unplanned fires to burn.
Underburnt	Fire frequency is below fire thresholds in the area. A prescribed burn may be advantageous. Consider allowing unplanned fires to burn.
Unknown	Inufficient data to determine fire threshold. NB. Fire thresholds defined for vegetation communities to conserve biodiversity.

Strategy Information	
Wildfires	Relatively short fire seasons, occurring between late November and mid February. Nearly all wildfires caused by lightning strike, with most occurring in mid-January.
Prescribed Burning (NPWS Fire Management Manual 4.7)	An annual program will be developed for prescribed burning. Priority areas will be determined according to burn prescriptions for different bushfire management regimes suitable for biodiversity conservation. Prescribed burns will be carried out as far as possible between late February and early April. Spring burns will not be undertaken in the wetter months.
